Dr. Hubka has served the osteopathic profession at the local, state, national, and international levels for over 30 years. According to Dr. Huntington-Alfano, "She has tirelessly represented and advocated for osteopathic physicians throughout her career in her many roles within the leadership of the AOA, AOF, and OPAC. She has served in leadership for the IOMS and remains an active and engaged member, assisting current leadership as an advisor, mentor, and friend." Her dedication, hard work, and vision clearly demonstrate her qualities as an exemplary leader. In addition, Dr. Hubka has represented the profession on numerous key education and policy initiatives that are critical to the future of osteopathic medicine.

Dr. Hubka graduated from Des Moines University/College of Osteopathic Medicine (DMU/COM) in 1989 and has served as President of the DMU/COM Alumni Association. She is dually board certified by AOA/AOBOG and ABOG in Obstetrics and Gynecology. Dr. Hubka is a Distinguished Fellow of the American College of Osteopathic Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOOG) and a Fellow of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOOG). Prior to entering medical school, she earned a BS degree in Biochemistry and Nutrition Science from University of California-Davis, and a Master of Science, Biology, and Clinical Nutrition from the University of Bridgeport, Bridgeport, CT. After graduating with her DO degree from DMU/COM, she completed a rotating internship at Atlantic City Medical Center/Mainland Hospital in Atlantic City, NJ, and her obstetrics and gynecology residency at Mercy Hospital and Medical Center in Chicago, IL, culminating in the role of Chief Administrative Resident.

Dr. Hubka has been in private practice as an obstetrician and gynecologic surgeon in Chicago for the past 29 years. She established Comprehensive Women's Care in 2000, re-branded as Comprehensive Wellness Care, LLC in 2011. She is a member of the Assembly of Osteopathic Graduate Medical Educators of the American Association of Colleges of Osteopathic Medicine. She has served as Chair of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology and has held the rank of Clinical Professor at Midwestern University/Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine (MWU/CCOM) since 2004. Dr. Hubka has taught extensively, both nationally and internationally, in the field of osteopathic obstetrics and gynecology, to include her service since 2004 as the obstetrics and gynecology residency program director at three different hospital systems, facilitating the amalgamation and preservation of two programs into the unified robust program it is today.

Dr. Hubka states, "I believe in the distinctive osteopathic philosophy and practice of medicine which I follow personally, and, passionately profess to my patients. I train students and residents to promote and preserve the difference they will make in their patients' lives through the practice of osteopathic medicine. I take great pride in being a DO and I am dedicated to giving back to the profession and to all future DOS!"

Serving on the AOA Board of Trustees since 2013, Dr. Hubka has actively participated on and chaired numerous AOA bureaus, councils, committees, and work-groups, and currently serves as advisor to the AOA Executive Committee, chairing the Certifying Board Services Viability Work-group. She is frequently called upon to chair critical-focus work groups, most recently the International Affairs Work group. She chaired the AOA Council of Women's Health Initiatives. She was one of the founding members and then President of the American Association of Osteopathic Postgraduate Physicians (AAOPP) currently integrated into the Bureau of Emerging Leaders (BEL). Dr. Hubka currently serves on the Osteopathic Political Action Committee - Board of Directors.

Dr. Hubka's tireless advocacy for osteopathic medicine has led to her work for the American Academy of Family Physicians, developing and teaching both the Basic and the Advanced Life Support in Obstetrics (BLSO & ALSO) Courses. She is a Fellow of the Institute of Medicine of Chicago and became a Costin Scholar in 2007-2008. Dr. Hubka serves on the Women's Preventative Services Initiative Multidisciplinary Steering Committee for the American College and Congress of Obstetricians and Gynecologists. She is a member and annual presenter at the Council of Resident Educators in Obstetrics and Gynecology and participates in the Association of Professors in Gynecology and Obstetrics (APGO), representing Midwestern University/ Chicago College of Osteopathic Medicine Department of OB/GYN, which is an APGO Institutional Member.

She is a past Chairman of the Board of the American Osteopathic Foundation from 2009-2010. In 2011-2012, Dr. Hubka served as President of the American College of Osteopathic Obstetrics and Gynecology. She chaired the Medical Education Foundation of ACOOG in 2014-2015. She was elected President of the IOMS for the 2000-2001 term and served on that board for over ten years in various leadership roles. Dr. Hubka has been a delegate to the AOA House of Delegates beginning in 1990 (since starting her residency) and prior to that, was a Student Delegate to the AOA House from 1985-1989. She has been the Illinois Delegation Chair since 2000.

Dr. Hubka is in the AOA Mentor Hall of Fame. She was the ACOG Educator of the Year in 2019-2020, as well as received the ACOOG Distinguished Service Award in 2014-2015 and recently honored the ACOOG 2022 Mentor of the Year. Dr. Hubka has received awards from MWU/CCOM, IOMS, DMU/COM, just to name a few of the many organizations who have chosen to honor her. She is a highly sought-after speaker and teacher with a long list of such engagements. As well, Dr. Hubka is involved in conducting research leading to numerous publications, as included on her resume. Additionally, Dr. Hubka is frequently engaged in international humanitarian work, serving in India, China and Guatemala. The Chicagoland community also benefits from her civic involvement in fund raising, speaking, and service as a women's health advisor.

Dr. Hubka is dedicated to her profession, her community and her family. She and her husband John Dunkas, of 31 years, enjoy spending time with their two grown children, Nikko and Yanni, who have been raised into the osteopathic family and have both served as pages in the AOA House of Delegates. Dr. Hubka is originally from San Diego, California where her family of eight siblings still resides with their families.
